Downloading Photos From Camera Using Windows XP

Connect Camera to Computer

Turn Camera On

You may get a screen that ask how you want to handle the transfer. If you do select “Use the Microsoft Scanner and Camera Wizard. Put a tick in the check box that says always use this option”.

The Camera and Scanner Wizard will open.

You will see this box. Just wait.

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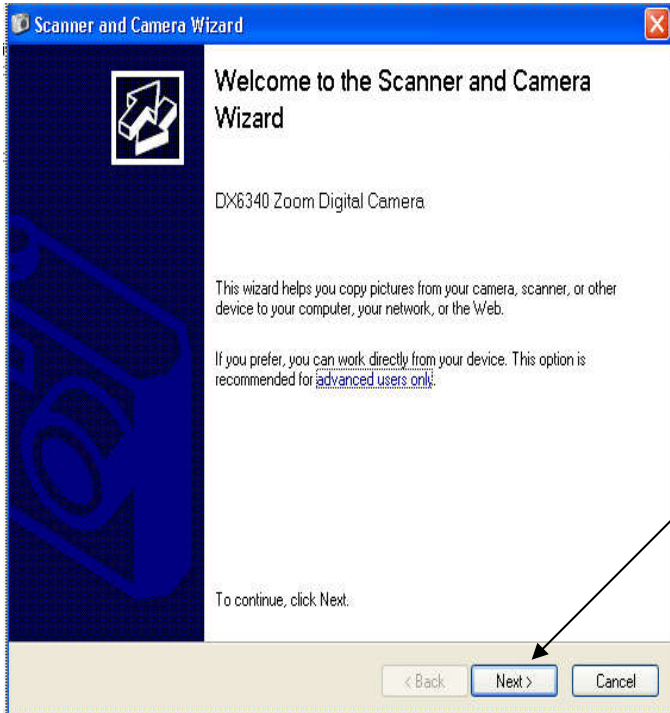

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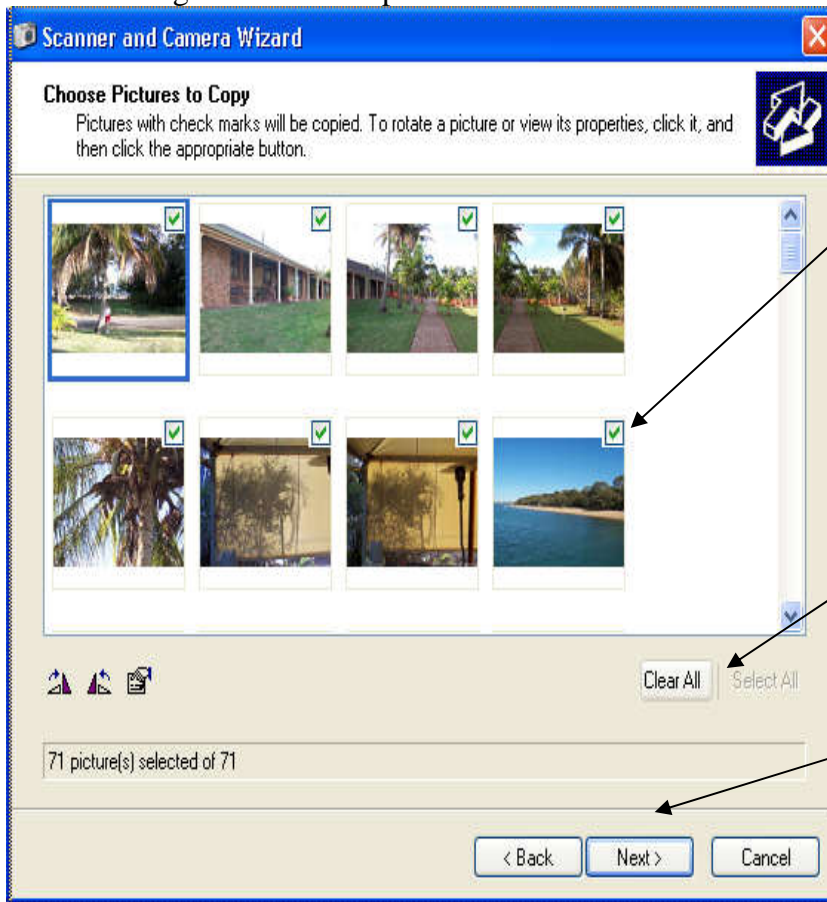
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After a short period the following window will open

Click Next

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


Type in a name for this group of photos. The photo files will have this name and a number indicating which photo it is.

The Following Window will appear.

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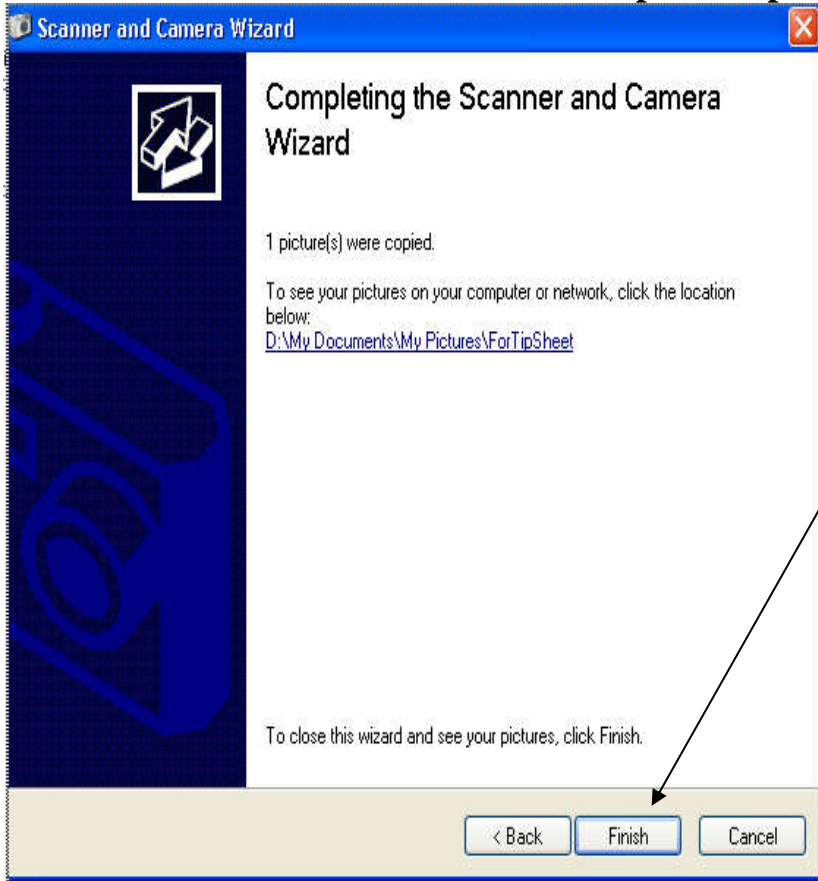
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Click Finish.
